The MoHAP named-patient coordination pathway — indicative 2026

The clinical situation

Daybue (trofinetide) is an FDA-approved oral IGF-1 tripeptide analogue indicated for patients aged 2+ with Rett syndrome, the first disease-modifying therapy for this rare X-linked neurodevelopmental disorder. Manufactured by Acadia. Dosed twice daily as an oral solution, weight-based. Diarrhoea and weight loss are common; hydration and nutritional monitoring are expected during treatment.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & genetic confirmation.** Treating paediatric neurologist confirms MECP2 variant and Rett clinical diagnosis; weight-based dose calculated with baseline hydration and nutritional status documented.
- 2 Treating centre & prescription confirmed.** A UAE tertiary paediatric neurology centre (Abu Dhabi or Dubai) issues the prescription and commits to ongoing monitoring.
- 3 MoHAP named-patient application.** Clinical rationale, genetic report, prescription, and product details are filed with MoHAP for named-patient import clearance.
- 4 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner; ambient courier shipment booked.
- 5 Dispensing & monitoring.** Oral solution delivered to the patient or treating centre; hydration, weight, and tolerability checked per label; refills coordinated on a 30-day cycle.

Indicative economics

Reference US cash-pay range: USD 375,000–575,000 per year drug-only, weight-based. Ambient logistics, MoHAP documentation, and concierge coordination are incremental. Full transparent quote at intake.

Indicative first-fill timing

7–14 days from a complete MoHAP application to first-fill delivery, once cohort intake opens. Indicative — not guaranteed.
