



# Doptelet in Egypt

The EDA named-patient coordination pathway — indicative 2026

## The clinical situation

Doptelet (avatrombopag) is an FDA-approved oral thrombopoietin receptor agonist (TPO-RA) indicated for thrombocytopenia in chronic immune thrombocytopenia (ITP) and in patients with chronic liver disease scheduled for procedures. Manufactured by Sobi. Dosed orally with food; dose individualized to platelet response. Stored at controlled room temperature.

### The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Your treating hematologist confirms chronic ITP diagnosis or procedure-related thrombocytopenia and documents the clinical rationale with platelet-count history.
- 2 Monitoring plan confirmed.** An Egyptian hematology clinic or tertiary hospital accepts the case for weekly CBC monitoring and dose titration.
- 3 EDA named-patient application.** Clinical rationale, patient reference, product details, and supply plan filed with the Egyptian Drug Authority.
- 4 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner.
- 5 Arrival & dispensing.** The clinic receives the supply; daily oral dosing with food, refills coordinated on a rolling basis.

### Indicative economics

**Reference US cash-pay range:** USD 6,000–7,500 per 30-day supply. Logistics, EDA documentation, and concierge coordination are incremental. Full transparent quote at intake.

### Indicative first-dose timing

**7–14 days** from a complete EDA application to first-dose delivery, once cohort intake opens. Indicative — not guaranteed.
