The clinical situation

Doptelet (avatrombopag) is FDA-approved for chronic immune thrombocytopenia (ITP) in adults with insufficient response to previous therapy, and for thrombocytopenia in adults with chronic liver disease (CLD) scheduled to undergo a procedure. Manufactured by Sobi, it is a small-molecule thrombopoietin (TPO) receptor agonist taken orally, with dosing independent of rigid meal-timing or food-interaction complexities that characterise some other oral TPO-RAs. For ITP: 20 mg once daily with food, titrated to target platelets $\geq 50 \times 10^7/L$. For CLD pre-procedure: 40–60 mg daily for 5 days starting 10–13 days before the procedure.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Your physician confirms chronic ITP with insufficient prior-therapy response, or chronic-liver-disease-associated thrombocytopenia prior to procedure, with baseline labs.
- 2 CDSCO named-patient / personal-use application.** Physician or importing pharmacy files dossier: rationale, patient reference, dosing plan.
- 3 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed specialty wholesale partner.
- 4 Shipment.** Controlled-room-temperature shipment with importer-of-record handling.
- 5 Arrival & dosing start.** Treating physician initiates titrated ITP dosing or the 5-day CLD procedural course.

Indicative economics

Reference US cash-pay range: USD 10,000–15,000 per 5-day CLD procedural course; USD 60,000–120,000 annualised for chronic ITP (Reserve Meds provides a transparent delivered quote at intake).

Indicative first-dose timing

14–21 days from a complete CDSCO application to first dispensed supply; procedural use requires 10–13-day pre-op buffer. Indicative — not guaranteed.
