The SFDA named-patient coordination pathway — indicative 2026

The clinical situation

Enjaymo (sutimlimab-jome) is an FDA-approved complement C1s monoclonal antibody indicated to decrease the need for red blood cell transfusions due to hemolysis in cold agglutinin disease (CAD). Manufactured by Sanofi. Administered as a weight-based IV infusion every 2 weeks after a loading phase; meningococcal, pneumococcal, and H. influenzae vaccination required. Requires 2–8°C cold-chain storage.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Your treating hematologist confirms CAD diagnosis with laboratory evidence of hemolysis and documents the clinical rationale and weight-based dose; required vaccinations administered.
- 2 Infusion centre confirmed.** A Saudi infusion centre or tertiary hospital (Riyadh, Jeddah, Eastern Province) accepts the case for every-2-week infusions.
- 3 SFDA named-patient application.** Clinical rationale, patient reference, product details, weight-based dose, and cold-chain plan filed with the Saudi Food & Drug Authority.
- 4 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner on validated 2–8°C cold-chain.
- 5 Arrival & administration.** The infusion centre receives the dose under temperature-monitored handling; maintenance every 2 weeks.

Indicative economics

Reference US cash-pay range: USD 45,000–55,000 per 2-week dose (weight-based). Cold-chain logistics, SFDA documentation, and concierge coordination are incremental. Full transparent quote at intake.

Indicative first-dose timing

7–14 days from a complete SFDA application to first-dose delivery, once cohort intake opens. Indicative — not guaranteed.
