The SFDA named-patient coordination pathway — indicative 2026

The clinical situation

Nurtec ODT (rimegepant) is an FDA-approved orally disintegrating tablet indicated for the acute treatment of migraine with or without aura and for the preventive treatment of episodic migraine in adults, manufactured by Pfizer (Biohaven). Nurtec is the first oral CGRP receptor antagonist approved for dual acute-and-preventive use from a single molecule. Dosing is 75 mg for an acute attack (max one dose per 24 hours) or every other day for prevention. It is typically considered when triptans are contraindicated or poorly tolerated, or when a single prescription covering both rescue and prevention is preferred.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Migraine diagnosis per ICHD-3, prior-therapy history (triptans, preventives), and the Nurtec rationale documented.
- 2 SFDA named-patient application.** Physician or importing pharmacy files clinical letter, patient identifier, and product details.
- 3 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner.
- 4 Shipment.** Nurtec ships at controlled room temperature; no cold-chain is required.
- 5 Arrival & dispensing.** The receiving facility dispenses per your neurologist's direction; refills ship on a rolling basis.

Indicative economics

Indicative first-dose timing

7–14 days from a complete SFDA application to first dispensation, once cohort intake opens. Indicative — not guaranteed.
