The clinical situation

Soliris (eculizumab) is an FDA-approved complement C5 monoclonal antibody indicated for paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria (PNH), atypical hemolytic uremic syndrome (aHUS), generalized myasthenia gravis, and neuromyelitis optica spectrum disorder. Manufactured by Alexion (AstraZeneca). Administered as an IV infusion every 2 weeks during maintenance; meningococcal vaccination required before initiation. Requires 2–8°C cold-chain storage.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Your treating hematologist or nephrologist confirms diagnosis with appropriate laboratory workup and documents the clinical rationale; meningococcal vaccination is administered.
- 2 Infusion centre confirmed.** A UAE infusion centre or tertiary hospital (Abu Dhabi, Dubai) accepts the case for every-2-week infusions.
- 3 MoHAP named-patient application.** Clinical rationale, patient reference, product details, and cold-chain plan are filed with the UAE Ministry of Health and Prevention.
- 4 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner on validated 2–8°C cold-chain.
- 5 Arrival & administration.** The infusion centre receives the dose under temperature-monitored handling; maintenance every 2 weeks.

Indicative economics

Reference US cash-pay range: USD 15,000–20,000 per 2-week dose. Cold-chain logistics, MoHAP documentation, and concierge coordination are incremental. Full transparent quote at intake.

Indicative first-dose timing

7–14 days from a complete MoHAP application to first-dose delivery, once cohort intake opens. Indicative — not guaranteed.
