The clinical situation

Tezspire (tezepelumab-ekko) is an FDA-approved thymic stromal lymphopoietin (TSLP) monoclonal antibody indicated as add-on maintenance therapy for severe asthma in patients 12 years and older, with efficacy independent of eosinophil phenotype or allergic status. Co-developed by Amgen and AstraZeneca. Dosed 210 mg subcutaneously every 4 weeks; requires 2–8°C cold-chain storage and specialist supervision for first-dose administration.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Your treating pulmonologist confirms severe-asthma diagnosis, prior ICS/LABA failure, and documents the clinical rationale for biologic add-on therapy.
- 2 Administration site confirmed.** A Saudi respiratory clinic or tertiary hospital accepts the case for first-dose supervision and follow-up injections.
- 3 SFDA named-patient application.** Clinical rationale, patient reference, product details, and cold-chain plan are filed with the Saudi Food & Drug Authority.
- 4 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner on validated 2–8°C cold-chain.
- 5 Arrival & administration.** The clinic receives the dose under temperature-monitored handling; maintenance doses every 4 weeks.

Indicative economics

Reference US cash-pay range: USD 3,800–4,500 per monthly dose. Cold-chain logistics, SFDA documentation, and concierge coordination are incremental. Full transparent quote at intake.
