The clinical situation

Wainua (eplontersen) is a subcutaneous GalNAc-conjugated antisense oligonucleotide targeting hepatic TTR mRNA, FDA-approved for the polyneuropathy of hereditary transthyretin-mediated amyloidosis (hATTR) in adults. Manufactured by Ionis/AstraZeneca. Administration is a 45 mg subcutaneous injection once monthly via an auto-injector, without the weekly platelet-and-urine monitoring burden of the earlier-generation ASO. Pre-treatment workup covers TTR genotype confirmation, vitamin A supplementation counselling, and baseline neurological assessment per FDA labelling.

The pathway, 5 steps

- 1 Consultation & clinical rationale.** Your neurologist or cardiologist documents hATTR polyneuropathy diagnosis, TTR genotype, and Wainua rationale.
- 2 Baseline workup.** Vitamin A counselling, neurologic baseline, ophthalmologic review per FDA labelling.
- 3 MoHAP named-patient application.** Physician or hospital pharmacy files clinical rationale, patient reference, monthly dosing plan, and chain-of-custody commitment.
- 4 US-side sourcing & logistics.** Reserve Meds coordinates product through our US-licensed DSCSA-compliant specialty wholesale partner with cold-chain 2–8°C shipment.
- 5 Arrival & first dose.** Dispensing pharmacy releases the monthly auto-injector; self-administration or clinic dosing arranged with the treating physician.

Indicative economics
